



## Info Sheet

- The market booths will be lined up on both sides of Main Street in front of the community centre on both Saturday June 2 and Sunday June 3, adding excitement to the community gathering in the Fair Grounds.
- To facilitate emergency access to the fair, booth areas will alternate on each side of the street. Each vending space is 10 feet long, but Main Street is not very wide, so depth of spaces may vary.
- Vendors, artisans, community groups, service groups and crafters (all will be known as vendors) will have excellent exposure since attendees to the annual event must walk past the vendors area to enjoy the fair.
- Bring along colorful tents, flags, and decorative ornamentation for your booth. Bright colored table coverings and table skirts are also encouraged. Bring weights and ties for your canopy. No chairs, tables or canopies are provided. It is all outdoors, rain or shine.
- If you are from out of town, Google the street address: 53 Main Street, Mount Albert, On.
- Set up is from 10 am till 12 noon and vendors will arrive by travelling eastward on Main Street. Please note that due to the timing and location of other events, vendors must wait till 10 am on Saturday to enter the area to set up.
- Upon arrival, vendors will be directed to the next available vendor space. Please unload your vehicle without setting up, move your vehicle to the Mount Albert Public School parking lot, or other designated parking area. Your complimentary gate pass, will allow you to enter the fairgrounds, Return to the vendor area and continue with set up.
- Closing time is 6 pm. No items may remain overnight.

Send your registration before May 18 and your cost will be kept at the same rate as in 2011.  
\$35 single space per day. \$50 single space for both days

After May 18, the fee structure is:  
\$45 for a single space for one day  
\$70 for a single space for two days  
\$20 for a single space for not-for-profit organization
